Dear Mother

Have just received
10th letter, that of Aug 18 all of
the other 9 have arrived safely.
Six letters and two cards in
this week's mail. The cards
and one letter from Moya,
2 from Aunt Lizzie one from
Aunt Emma and yours of
Aug 4. 11. and 18th. The book
let you make me wish I
were there. Lots of the fellows
get papers and magazines every
week from home. We do not have
thunder showers but lots of
rain. In regards to the visi-
tance it is \$5.00⁰⁰ additional
making \$10.00⁰⁰ in all am al-
ways glad to get mail, but I
can't write any news to you
except that I am well. The
nearest Y.M.C.A. where one can
write letters is about 3 miles
away, but we have Y.M.C.A.
canteens close by.
