Dear Mother

Have just received  
10<sup>th</sup> letter that of Aug 18 all of  
the other 9 have arrived safely.  
Six letters and two cards in  
this weeks mail. The cards  
and one letter from Myra,  
2 from Aunt Lizzie one from  
Aunt Emma and yours 3 of  
Aug 4. 11. and 18<sup>th</sup>. The book  
let sure makes me wish I  
were there. Lots of the fellows  
get papers and magazines every  
week from home, we do not have  
thunder showers, but lots of  
rain. In regards to the insur-  
ance it is \$5,000<sup>00</sup> additional  
making \$10,000<sup>00</sup> in all am al-  
ways glad to get mail, but I  
cant write any news to you  
except that I am well. The  
nearest y.m.c.a. where one can  
write letters is about 3 miles  
away, but we have y.m.c.a.  
canteens close by.
